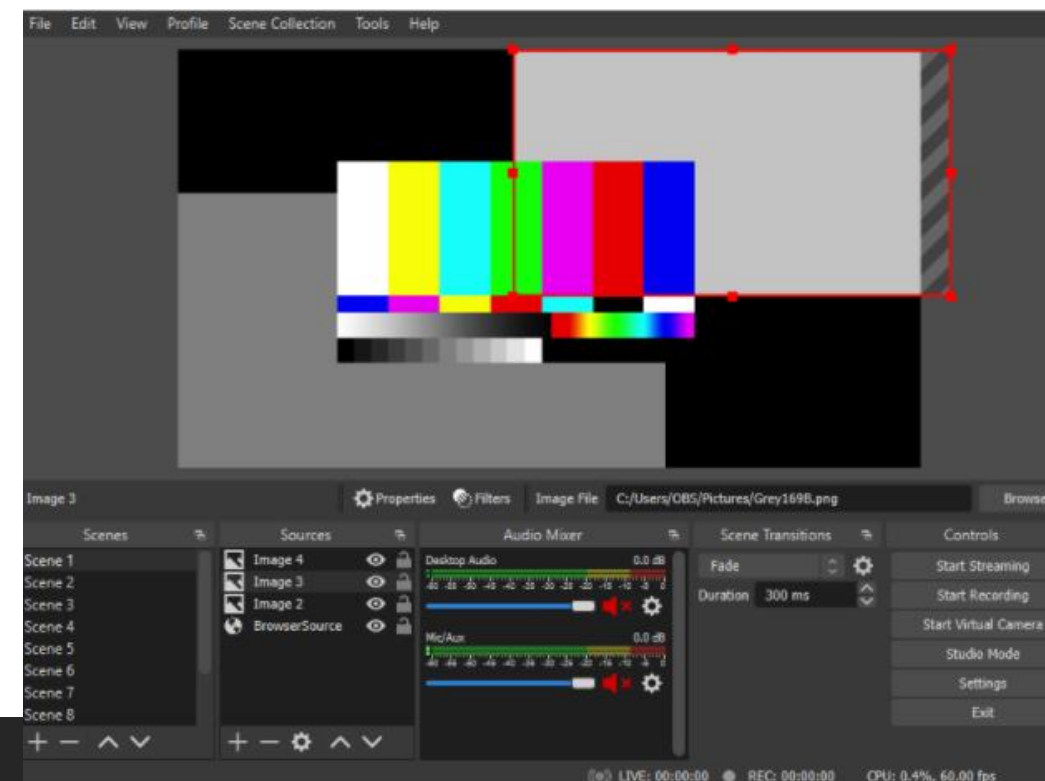
# Download OBS

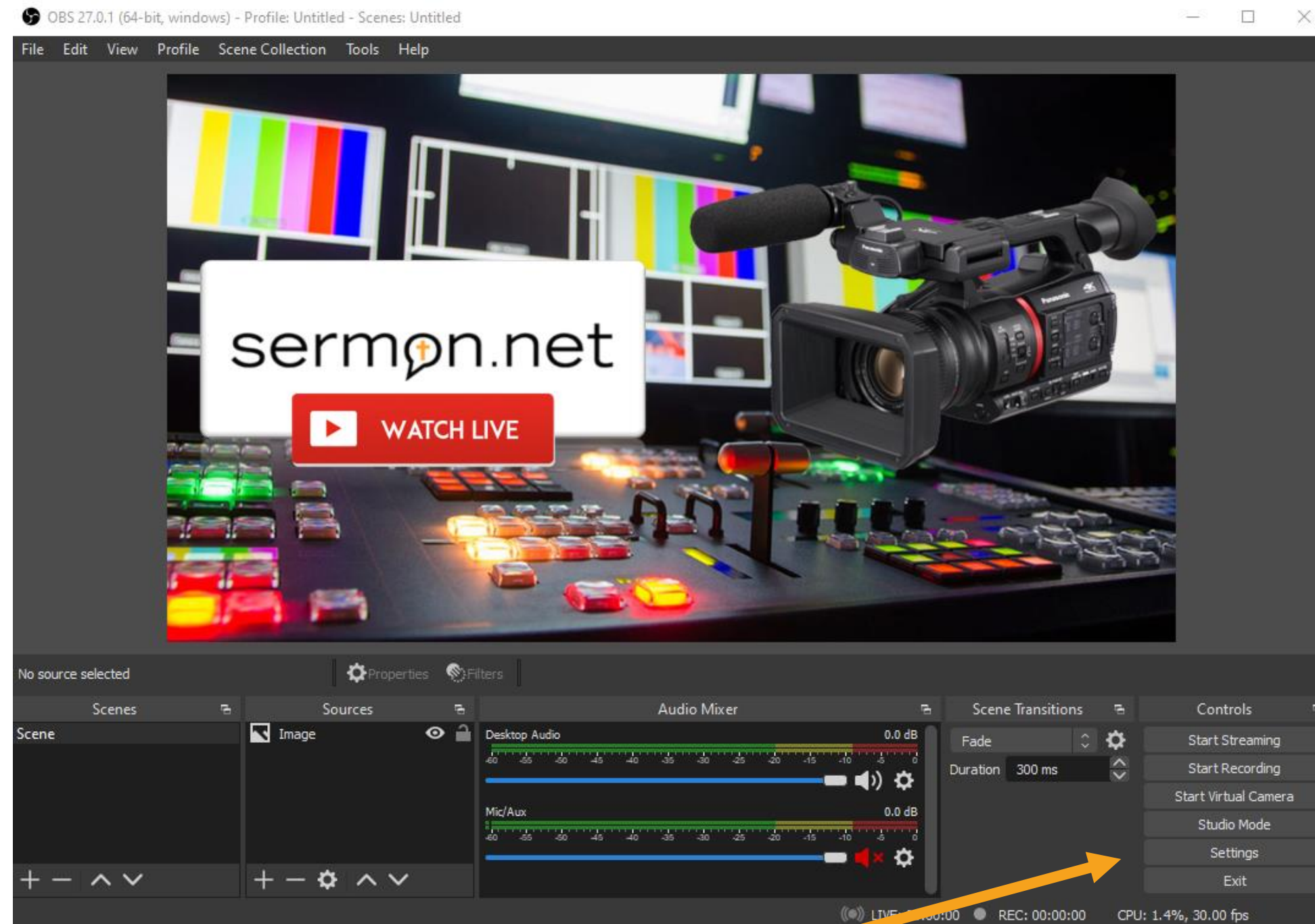

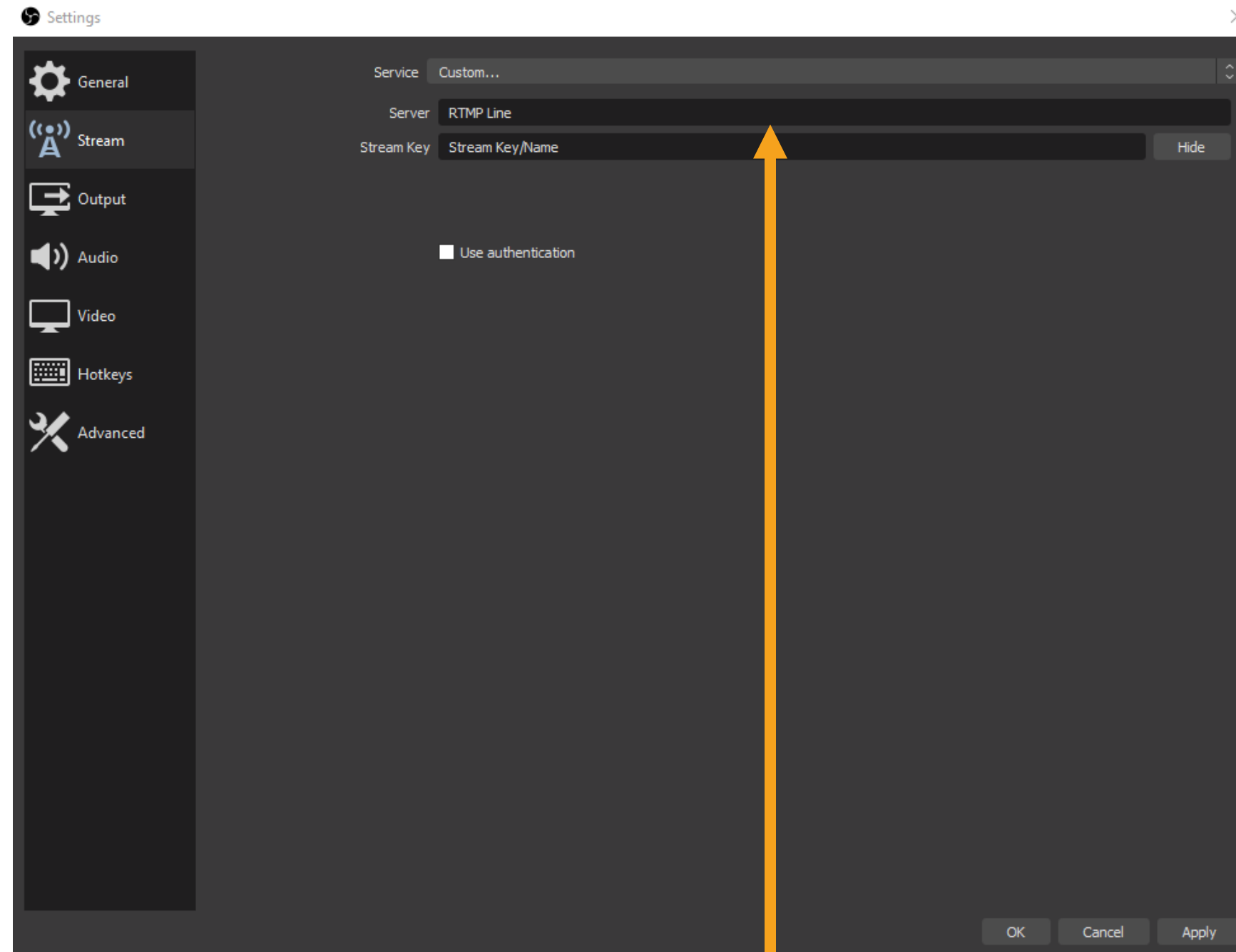

Paste Stream Credentials Into OBS – Open OBS > Click Settings

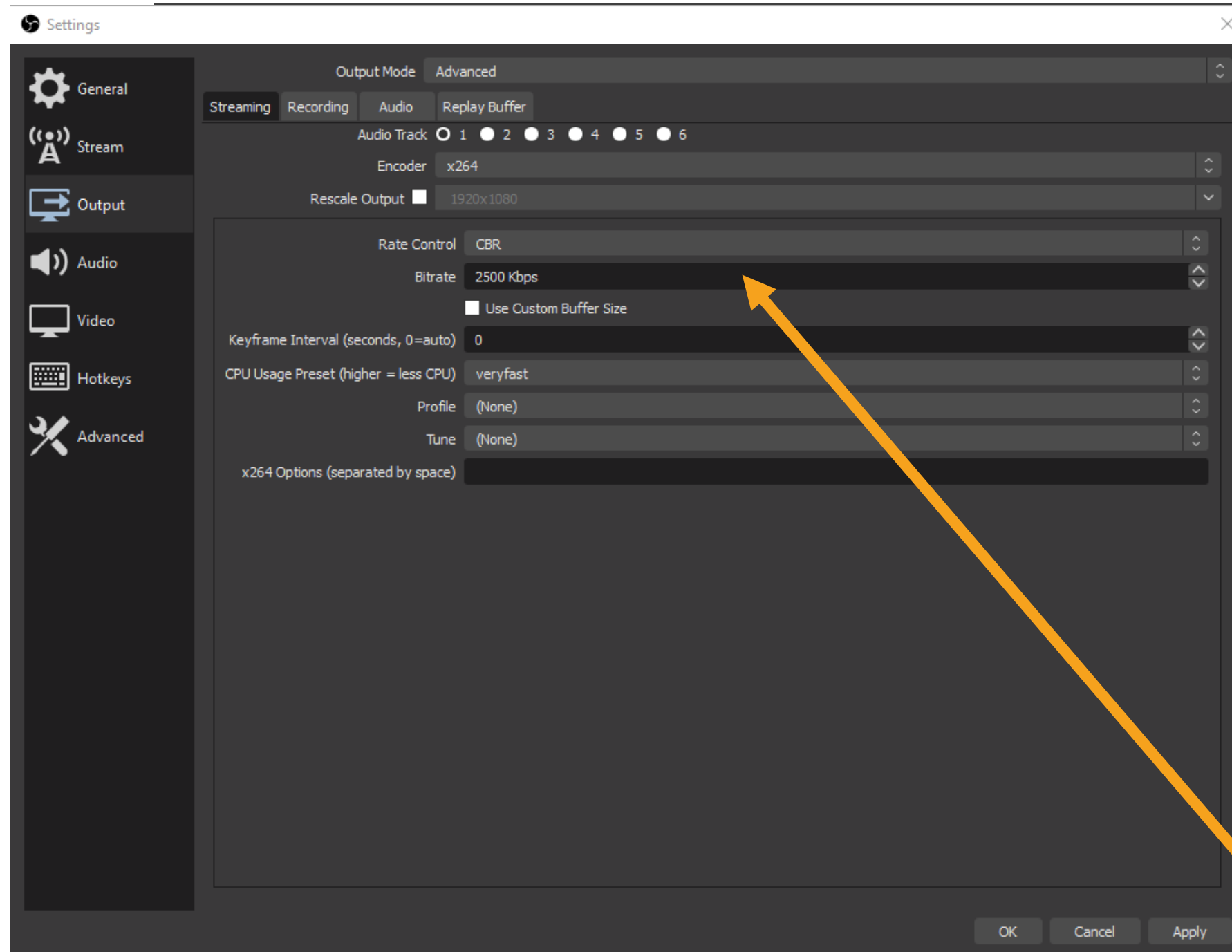
# Setup OBS

# Setup Bitrate



Video bit rate will need to be set from anything ranging from 800kbs to 2500kbs

This is just a suggestion. Set to what you need.

Audio will need to be set from 64kbs to 128kbs  
Click on the tab

Click On Output > Advanced Mode > Video Bitrate > Suggested is 2500kbs For Audio Bit rate 128kbs

# Set Resolution



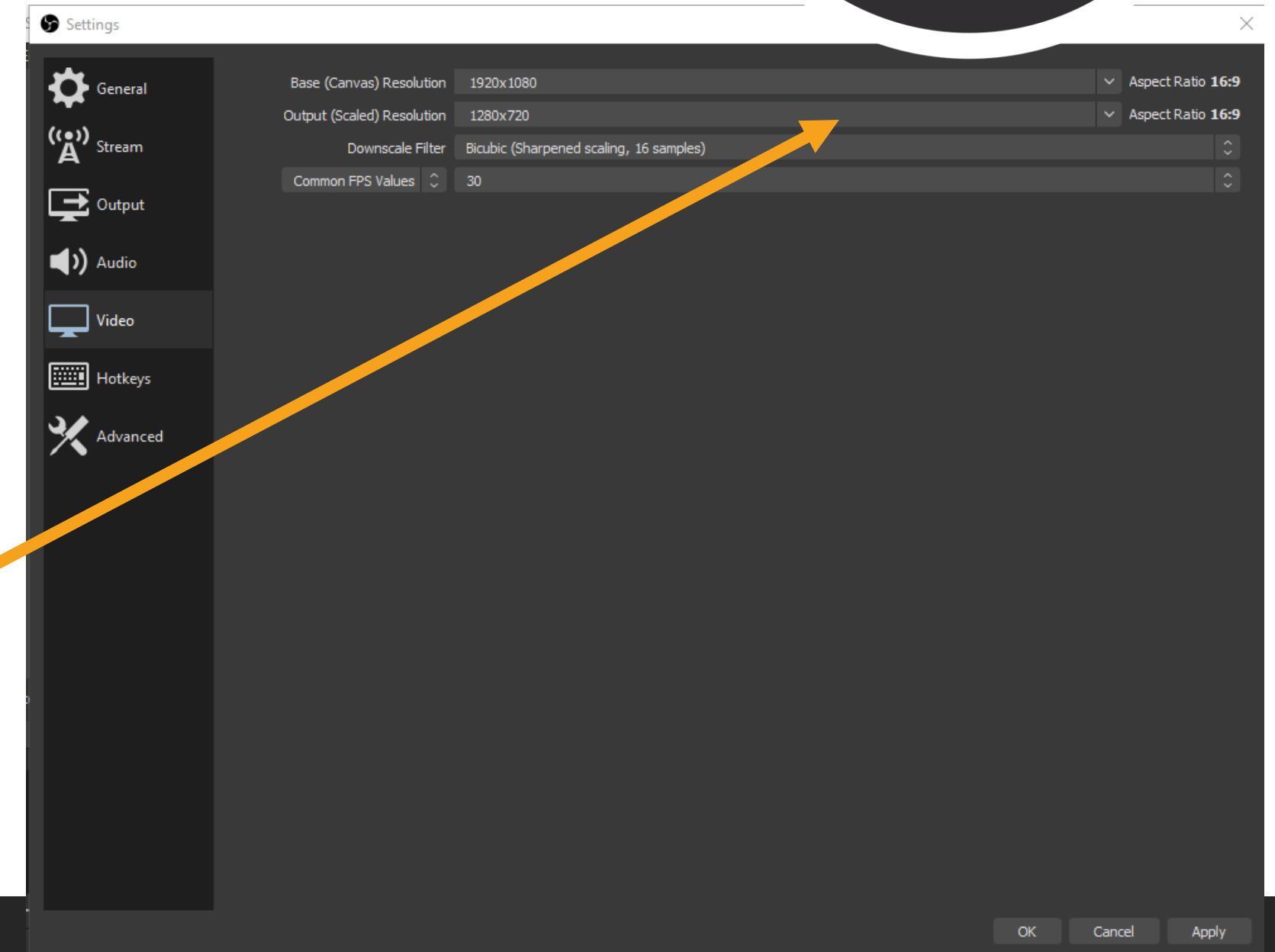

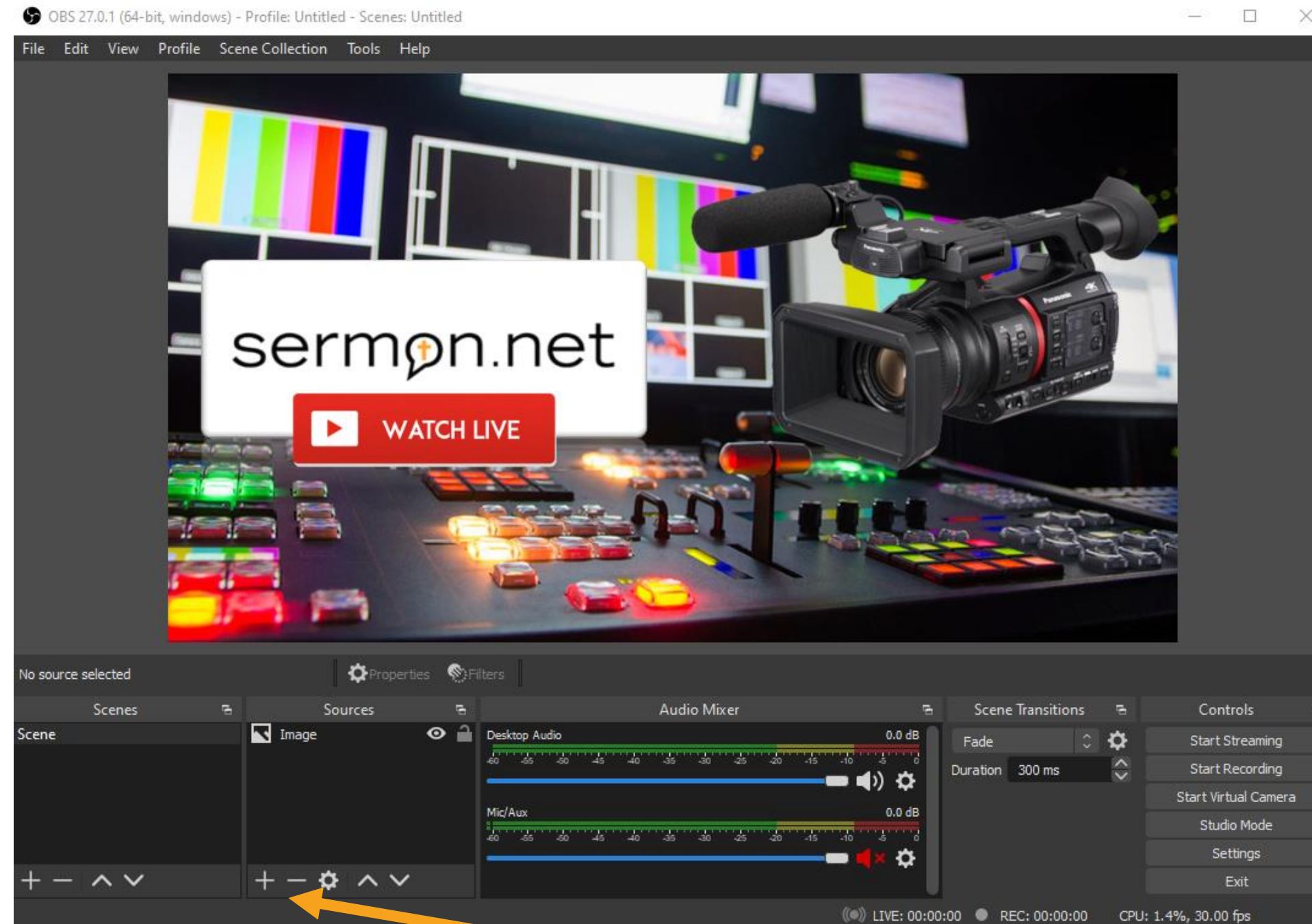

Click On Video > Set your resolution > Press Apply/OK

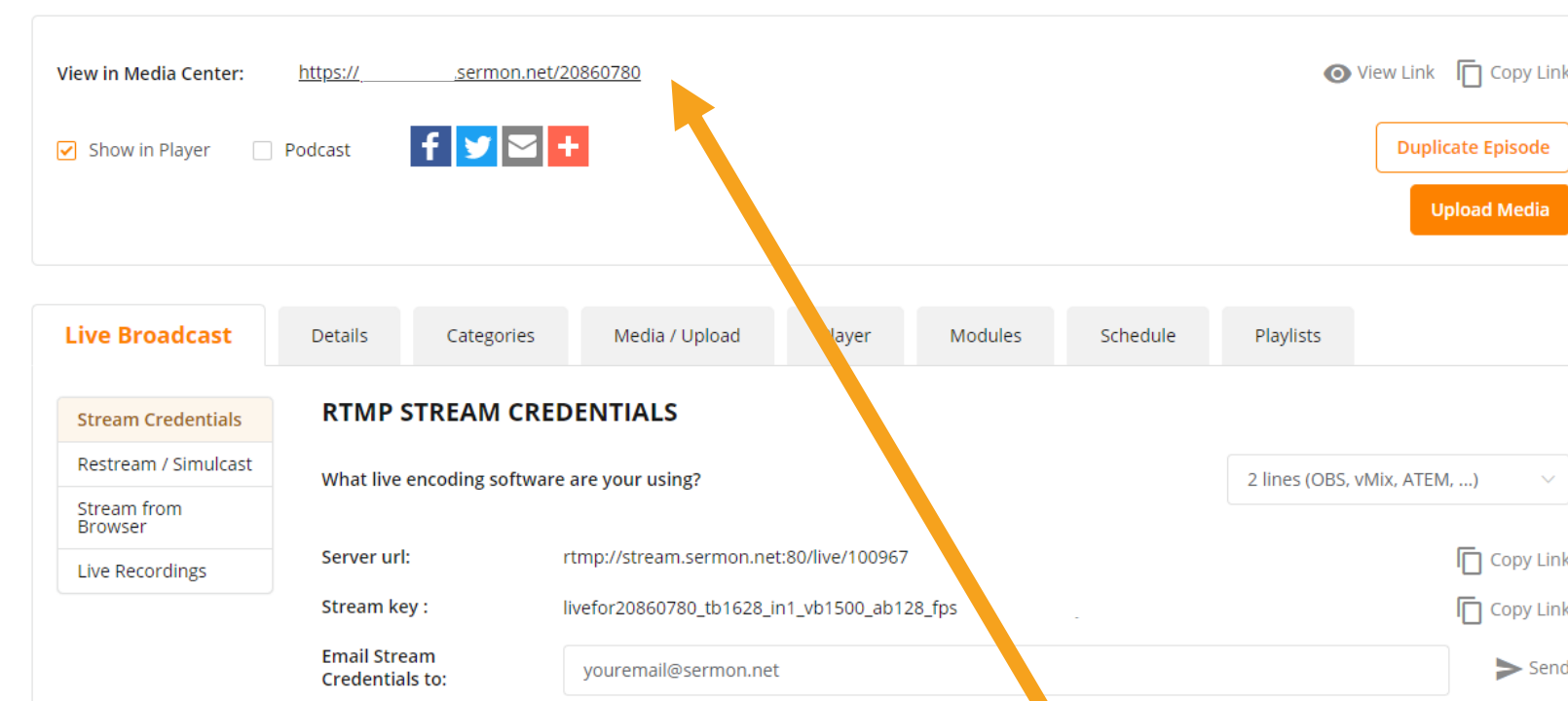
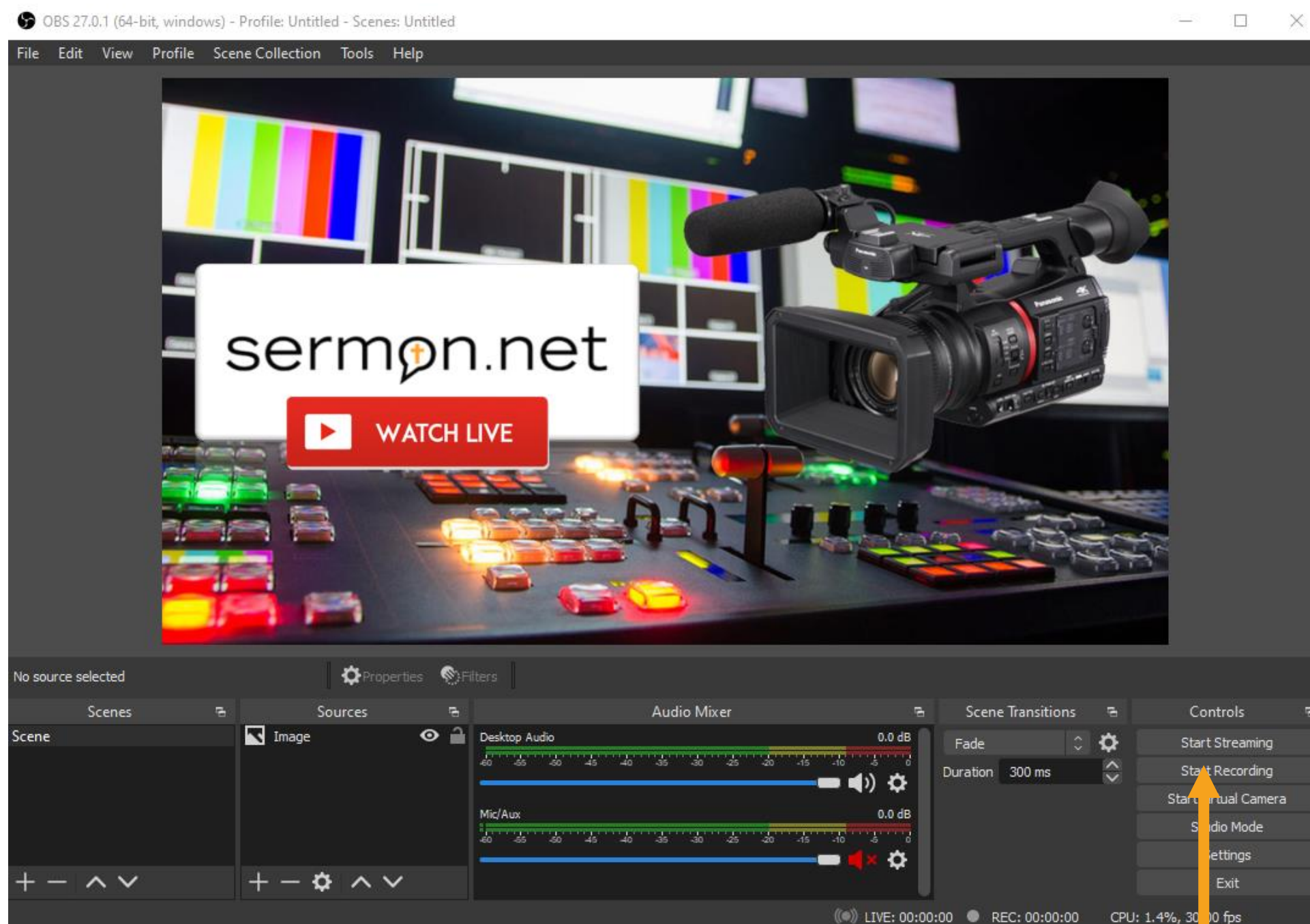

To Stream Click, Start Streaming – Best practice is to also record locally as well

# Best Practice

---



- If you are having trouble, please restart your computer
- To Start or Stop the recording – Press Record
- To Start or Stop the streaming – Press Stream
- If the stream breaks into several files. This means your stream will be dropping and you are overloading your computer.
- Wired Internet Connection Works the best

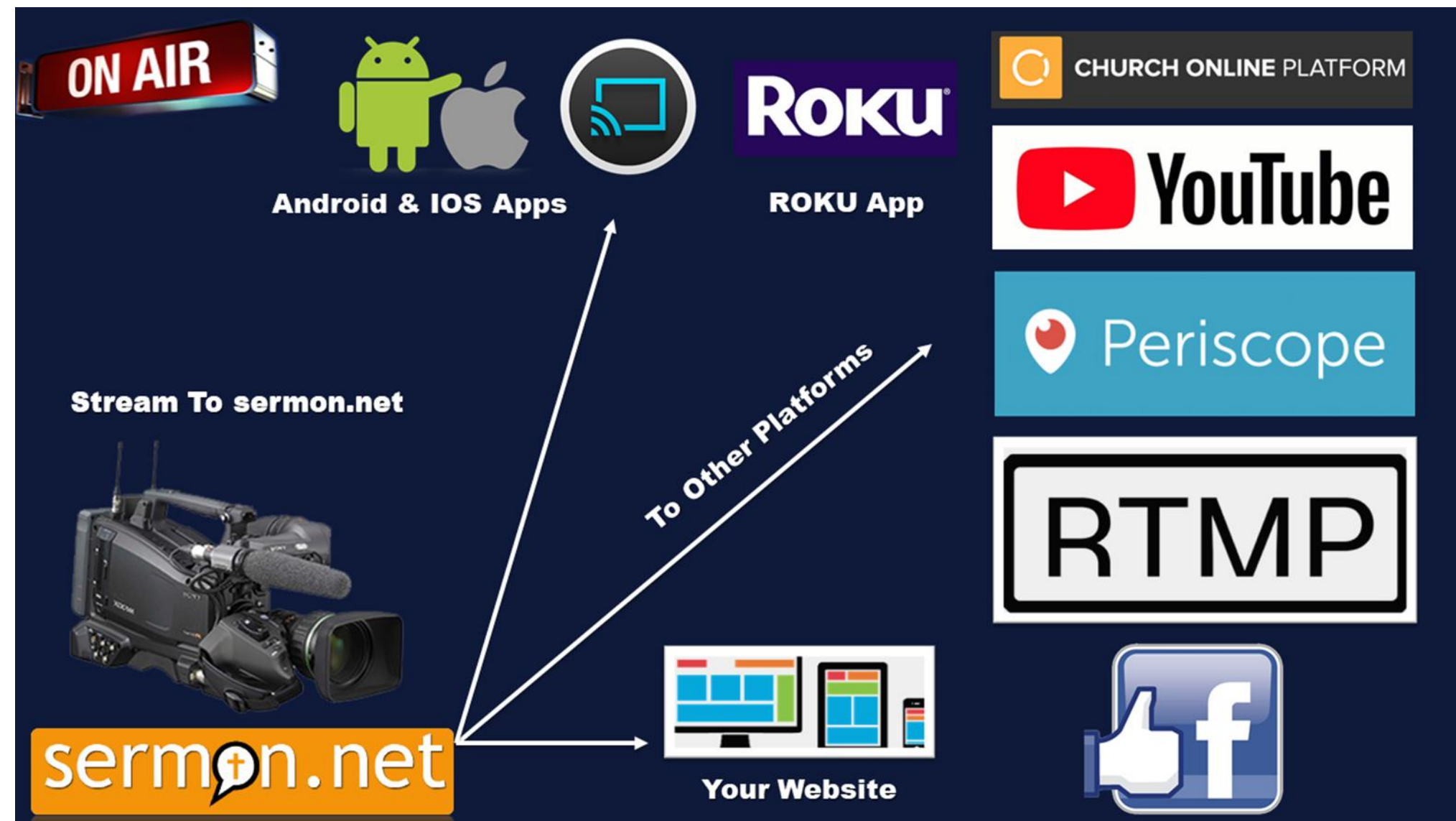
