

# How to ReStream To Facebook

# 2 Ways to Connect

## Simple Mode

You would login through sermon.net and connect your Facebook profile, page, or group.

When you are live streaming to sermon.net the feed will appear on your Facebook feed

Set it and your done.

**Simple mode works great if you don't want to have to setup Facebook for each broadcast.**

**Advanced you would need to setup for each broadcast.**

**Note this does take time to push to the Facebook server - Generally around 2-3 minutes**

## Advanced Mode

If you want to use the Facebook Producer or to schedule the post on Facebook this is the method to use

Create a live post on Facebook, schedule the post, and copy the server/stream name keys over to your sermon.net net account. With the advanced mode you would need to do this every time you want to go live on Facebook



1. Login to the YouTube account that you want to simulcast to.
2. Make sure you have Live Streaming enabled in Channel > Status and Features.
3. Click on your account Profile icon in the upper right.
4. Click on YOUTUBE STUDIO.
5. Click on CREATE > GO LIVE.
6. Click on STREAM NOW CLASSIC (or New Mode if preferred)
7. Scroll down to ENCODER SETUP to obtain your SERVER URL and STREAM NAME / KEY.
8. Copy and paste these credentials into the spaces provided below. (Within your Studio's > . Live Episode > Simulcast section.)

Start your Stream within your live encoder (OBS, VMIX, etc.) to your Sermon Studio > Live Episode's stream credentials. That's it! The stream you send to us will also be sent to YouTube.

- ▶ Start your feed 5-10 minutes early. Good time to test the stream and run announcements.
- ▶ The push to Facebook averages 2 minutes
