For Mac – Angry IP Scanner




Using the DataVideo IP Scanner

Click on Operation Mode from the menu








To get the stream credentials go to your sermon.net account

- 1. Click on the Episode Manager
- 2. Episode Archive
- 3. Select your Live broadcast episode
- 4. Live Broadcast Tab > Stream Credentials
- 5. Copy the Server url and paste in the rtmp field
- 6. Copy the Stream Key to the Stream name field












Click on Live Broadcast Episode






Click on Live Broadcast Tab






Click on Stream Credentials Tab





Copy the server url into the rtmp field Copy the stream name into stream name or key field






Video bit rate will need to be set from anything ranging from 2-3mb

Audio will need to be set from 64kbs to 96kbs Click on the tab

SD 640x360 16x9 widescreen


HD 1280x720 16x9 widescreen HD 1920x1080 16x9 widescreen HD 3840x2160 16x9 widescreen





DataVideo Tips

- If you are having trouble, please restart the DataVideo Unit
- To Start or Stop the recording Press Record
- To Start or Stop the streaming Press Stream
- To Start or Stop the streaming/record Press Stream & Record
- If the stream breaks into several files. This means your stream will be dropping and you are overloading your computer.
