




#### **Click on Select New Destination**





**Click on Generic RTMP** 






- To get the stream credentials go to your sermon.net account
- 1. Click on the Episode Manager
- 2. Episode Archive
- 3. Select your Live broadcast episode
- 4. Live Broadcast Tab > Stream Credentials
- 5. Copy the Server url and paste in the rtmp field
- 6. Copy the Stream Key to the Stream name field

\*\*Note that you do need to add // after the Server/Url line
Also Need to set your bitrate to 2-3mb










# Click on Stream Credentials Tab





## Copy the server url into the rtmp field Copy the stream name into stream name or key field






Video bit rate will need to be set from anything ranging from 2-3.5mb This is just a suggestion. Set to what you need.



#### **LiveU Solo Tips**

- If you are having trouble, please restart the LiveU
- To Start or Stop the streaming Give the box power
- If the stream breaks into several files. This means your stream will be dropping and you are overloading your internet connection. You will need to lower the bit rate some.
- If you are not getting a signal to sermon.net double check that the server/url has // after the credential.
- Also to limit your bitrate. What you send us is what we send out.
